DUO SCHOLARSHIP: PRIORITY COUNTRY PROGRAMME FLEMISH GOVERNMENT PXL – NWU (COMPRES)

TWO(2) duo scholarships in the priority country programme between PXL UAS AND NWU (COMPRES) IS AVAILABLE FOR AUTUMN 2022 (SEPTEMBER 2022–JANUARY 2023).

This is a fully paid scholarship for one academic semester in HASSELT, BELGIUM, and is open for any student at NWU (not only social work and Psychology) and may include graduate as well as postgraduate applications. Important to notice the time frame thus, a full-time postgraduate student might be a better option.

The programme is a rich intercultural experience and will enable an NWU student to fully understand the global perspective of a Global South country through the lenses of the Global North.

What is needed:

- Motivation letter of the student (maximum twoA4 pages) with a personal and academic/professional motivation.
- Official Transcript of records of the current and, if applicable, previous academic years during the current bachelor or master programme.
- A signed Letter of recommendation from a professor or lecturer of the home institution
- A signed learning agreement with the courses they will take at PXL see second attachment (this can be changed afterwards).

The students have to stick to one department (PXL-Healthcare, PXL-Business, PXL-Social Work or PXL-Education). Please be aware that the courses are at the bachelor's level. However, it is not a prerequisite for enrolment; thus – Masters's

students enrolling for undergraduate modules as part of the exchange will be permitted.
