



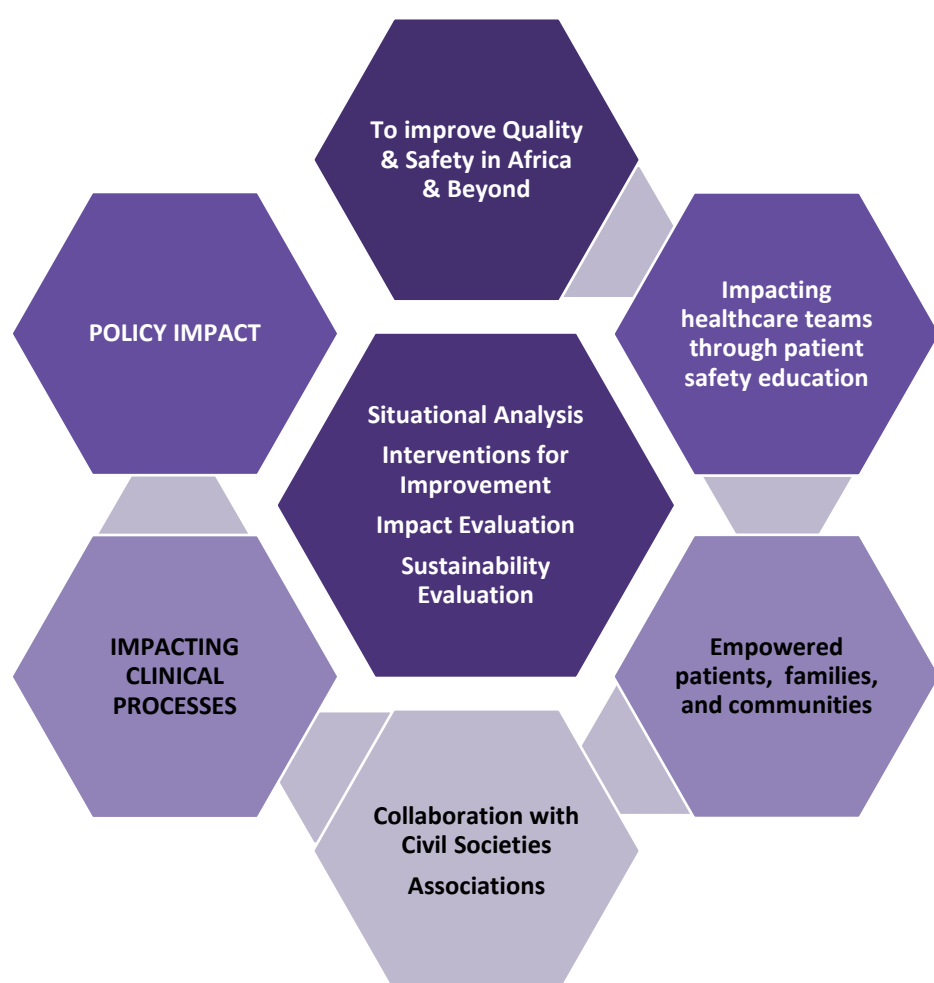
Safe & Quality Care IMPACT
